Overview of the CUK GLOBAL SUMMER SCHOOL!

The Catholic University of Korea has been working hard to promote our international education programs for international students. We have been offering the "CUK Global Summer School" since 2009. Through this program, students gain a wide range of background knowledge about the traditions, society, and the dynamics of contemporary South Korea, both in and out of classrooms.



PROGRAM DATES

The program runs from July 4, 2014, to August 1, 2014. Students are expected to arrive on campus on Thursday, July 3 and depart on Saturday, August 2.

WEEKLY PROGRAMS

- Korean language classes: 3 hours per week
- Korea Studies: 12 hours per week
This includes Korean Society, History, Culture and Economics.
- Special fun-filled "Activity in the Afternoon" programs including a special one-day activity every Friday.





PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

1. Korean Studies (3 Credits)

CGSS provides opportunities to understand more about Korea, which is one of the most influential countries in global economy, its history, people and the functioning of the society - 3 credits for 4 weeks.

2. Enriching Cultural Experience

- Diverse field trips (including traditional and modern destinations)
- Authentic cultural experience through Korean Folk Village
- Multicultural Environment : Making new friends from other countries at CUK, sharing ideas, and learning about new cultures

HOUSING

Students are placed in double rooms with shared bathrooms. Our dormitories accommodate males and females separately. 24-hour security and dormitory office staff members are available during off-hours for any type of emergency.
