### ➤ Accommodation

--Week days:

We don't provide the accommodation in Taipei (2 nights, Jul.10&11).

### ➤ Internet

We provide Wi-Fi account in Taipei Campus. And in the dormitory in Taoyuan, we provide both cable network and wireless network. You can bring your laptop and the internet cable to connect the internet.

➤ Pickup and Transportation

We'll do the pick-up in Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport.

**On 7/4, the pick-up time for terminal 2 will be 19:30 and terminal 1 will be 19:45.**

**We and our culture ambassador will arrive at both terminals at 18:00.**

We'll wait at arrival lobby with a sign and please meet us there.

**On 7/18, the departure time will be 8:30 to terminal 2 and 9:30 to terminal 1.**

We also arrange the daily bus transportation between NTUB Taipei Campus and Dormitory in Tao-yuan campus, the bus for field trip in Yi-Lan and the bus to company visit.

**Only the two days trip in Taipei would not be included. (Students can buy the easy card for MRT or Bus in Taipei City)**

➤ Weekend Free Time in Taipei (Jul.10-12)

The weekend will be free time for the students; therefore we will bring them to Taipei and set them free on Friday afternoon. We will not arrange activities during the weekend. Students need to find the hotels by themselves and stay there for the whole weekend.

We will pick them up on Sunday afternoon, back to Taoyuan campus.

➤ Luggage During Weekend

You can bring a small bag or a backpack and put the things you need during the weekend. You can leave your big luggage in the dorm and bring a small one with you on 7/10.

➤ Food

We'll provide food (breakfast, lunch and dinner) in week days from Mon. – Fri.

Students should be in charge of the meals themselves during weekend in Taipei

Temperature in July: 28-35°C

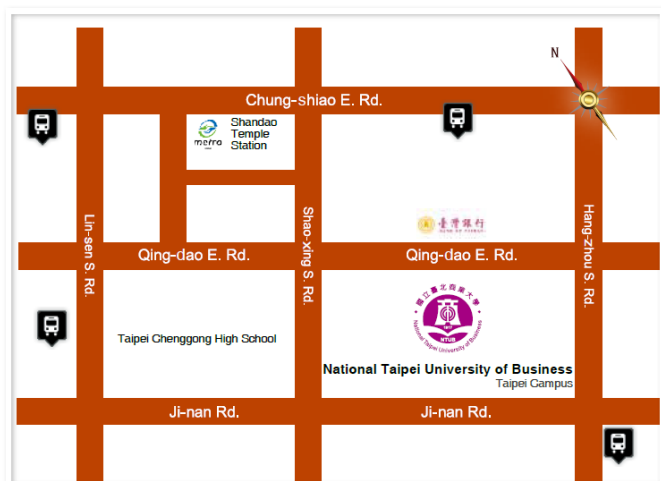
Electricity in Taiwan: 110V or 220V, alternating at 60 cycles per second.

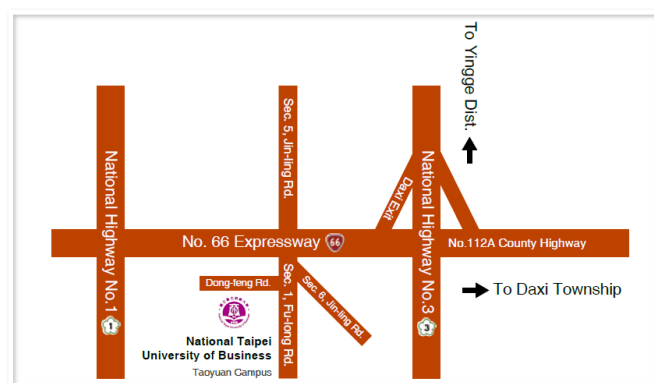
